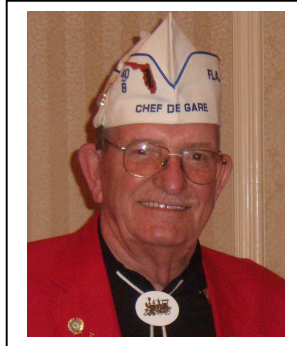

Grand Avocat: The Grand Constitution is going to be updated at our upcoming Grand Prom. Proposed changes as of Petite Prom are up on Ben Meredith's Grande du Florida Website. The current Constitution is up on V215's Website. It takes a 2/3rd's vote to approve any changes.

Grand Ritual: The 2010 Petite Communique is out

with all the Report Forms. Get your Ritual Report to me in time for Grand Prom so I can heap praise and adulations upon your Voiture. Ritual Report templates in MS Word and a short form report are available on V215's Website.

Unfortunately, four of our large Voitures have less than 50%, which accounts for 120 Voyageurs. That is almost half of what we are short. A big merci to V-1219 which has taken the lead in membership. Wouldn't it be great if we could go to the Grand Promenade and give Grand Chef Archie 100% in membership?

Each Voiture is still the judge of its own membership. It is still an honor to be invited to join La Societe. We should all be looking for that veteran or active duty service person that is active in our communities and honor them with an invitation to join La Societe. Call that delinquent Voyageur and see if why they have not renewed.

This is the time of year that we should be thinking of officers for your locale for 2010-11. We should also be looking for a Grand Cheminot to represent your region during the coming year.

Even though Grand Cheminot is an easy position, it is a very important one. The Grand Cheminot is the liaison between the Voiture locale and Voiture Grand du Florida. This is your voice in Grand du Florida.

Our constitution, Article VII, Section 6, states: "The Grand Cheminots elected from the various regions shall have a further and singular duty placed on them; i.e., they and each of them shall visit, if possible, all Voitures Locale in their respective regions as many times during the year as possible. They shall become familiar with the ritualistic work as provided in the Ritual of La Societe and see that all provisions of the Ritual are properly carried out within the Promenade Locale. The Grand Cheminot shall preside at all Regional Promenades. Regional Grand Cheminots shall prepare and submit a written report for the year's activities within their Region to the Grand Correspondant and the Grand Promenade. Each Regional Grand Cheminot shall be the membership chairman within the Region from which he was elected and he shall promote the membership in all Voitures Locale within it."

Besides electing a Grand Cheminot, this is also a good time to think about being a Sous

Director of one of our great programs. If you or someone you know has a passion for one of our programs, send their name and contact information to me. The future of Grand du Florida is up to you.

Another way to make our Voitures Locale better is visitations. Consider visiting the Promenade of a neighboring Voiture Locale. In order to do this we need to know where and when you hold your Promenade. E-mail me with your Voiture number, day, time and location of your Promenade, a contact name and number, and indicate if you have a Cabane.

So let’s discuss the last 3 categories. **DISCLAIMER** “*There are many more examples I have not listed, so do not limit your activities to my examples*”.

4. COMMUNITY ACTIVITIES: Blood donor, Community Services, Get out the vote, National Security, Political Action, Senior Citizens, Hunter safety, Poppy Sales, Special Olympics, meetings, Promenades, Wrecks and activities in other Fraternal Organizations. **Note!** *This category includes anything you do in your community i.e. food drives, Meals on Wheels, library support, Adopt a Road (clean up) Program, Clean up Our Waters Program, holding an elected office in your community, etc.*

5. HOLIDAYS AND MEMORIALS: Calvin Kain Memorial Service, Grave Decoration, 4th of July, Memorial Day, Memorial Services, funerals, memorial dedications, Parades, patriotic events, installations, Veterans Day. **Note!** *This is self explanatory, but participation includes as a spectator part of the ceremony.*

6. VETERANS: Veterans Home, transportation to Hospitals/doctors, Veterans Employment, other. **Note!** *If you provide transportation for a Veteran to shop, get medical prescriptions, food, clothes, entertainment, etc. Also, if you do the shopping for the Veteran and they do not accompany you. POW/MIA activities. Just about anything you do to help a Veteran in need.*

The bottom line is that you report your activities to you Voiture and they file their report to me annually.

I have Americanism Pins and would like to sell them and I know many Voitures have not asked for them.

## **VAVS NEWS**

I regret that Mary and I will miss some of the upcoming events as she is recovering from double pneumonia. We will make the Grand Promenade in June and hope to see you there.

**Hope for VA budget increase:** Despite plans to give the Veterans Affairs Department a 7% budget increase at a time when most federal spending is frozen, key congressional committees are pushing for even bigger veterans budgets. They just can't agree on how much more to give. At the low end, Democrats on the Senate Veterans' Affairs Committee are recommending a \$380 million increase in the \$56.9 billion VA budget proposed by the Obama administration. At the high end, Republicans on the House Veterans' Affairs Committee are recommending a \$2.6 billion increase.

**VA Help to Homeless Vet's:** The VA is allocating \$39 million to fund about 2,200 new transitional housing beds through grants to local providers. "VA is committed to ending the cycle of homelessness among Veterans," said Secretary of Veterans Affairs Eric K. Shinseki. "We will use every tool at our disposal - health care, education, jobs, safe housing - to ensure our Veterans are restored to lives with dignity, purpose and safety."

**VA to speed Vietnam Claims:** The VA announced 9 MAR an aggressive new initiative to solicit private-sector input on a proposed "fast track" Veterans' claims process for service-connected presumptive illnesses due to Agent Orange exposure during the Vietnam War. In practical terms, Veterans who served in Vietnam during the war and who have one of the illnesses covered by the "presumption of service connection" don't have to prove an association between their medical problems and military service. This "presumption" makes it easier for Vietnam Veterans to access disability compensation benefits. Vietnam Veterans are encouraged to submit their claims as soon as possible to begin the important process of compensation.

**Shingles Vaccine Available:** A vaccine for shingles, which the VA helped develop, is

available to veterans who are patients at VA medical facilities nationwide

**Medicare-Tricare Cuts Delayed:** President Obama signed legislation (H.R. 4691) on 2 MAR which will delay the 21% cut in doctor reimbursement rates for providers who see Medicare and TRICARE patients that was scheduled to take effect on 1 MAR. The bill also provides relief from the \$1,860 Medicare therapy coverage cap, helping many stroke and accident victims whose 2010 expenses were already bumping against the cap. Unfortunately the extension only delays the cuts for 30 days to 1 APR. This short-term legislation is intended to give lawmakers time to work on a package that would include longer-term extensions and/or a more permanent resolution to the reimbursement problem.

**Bay Pines Adds Two New Facilities:** The Bay Pines VA Medical Center has broken ground and will construct a 2-story building, planned for almost 30,000 square feet. The new building will house a new Eye Treatment Center on the first floor and an Ambulatory Surgery Center on the second floor. The building, expected to open in 2011, will be freestanding and will be connected to the northeast side of the current hospital.

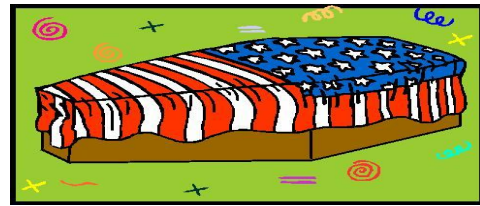

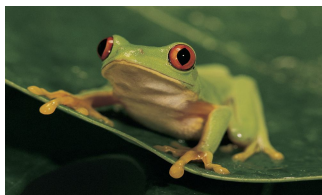
